

English

We have started the term with a whole school focus on the book Pocket Book of Pocket Poems by A. F. Harrold. We will be looking at narratives, fables and non-chronological reports. We will focus on conjunctions and using different sentence types.

D&T - Our units are textiles and food and nutrition.

Home Learning

Home Learning will be set using Google Classroom. The children will be set spellings to practise that are aligned to the spelling rules that we have been learning in class.

Children should read every day and should be listened to doing so wherever possible. We will be using reading diaries as a way of communication, please can this be signed and comments added when you have listened to your child read.

Children should also practise their maths skills and multiplication tables on a regular basis: using Mathletics or Times Table Rock Stars for about 10 minutes five times per week will help.
