

## English

This term will begin with a whole school focus using The Tree and the River. We will also write labels, lists & captions as well as poetry. We will be revising our phase 2 and 3 phonics and begin to learn phases 5 phonics using the Little Wandle scheme.

## PE

This term we will be teaching the following units:

- Gymnastics
- Fundamentals
- Dance
- Ball Skills

## Maths

We will be covering many skills this term, including: positional language, representation of number, using part, part whole models, addition and subtraction, making 10 and some more and doubling and halving.

## Science

Seasonal change and trees: We will learn about the 4 seasons and the weather. We will explore the parts of a tree and learn about the different types of tree.

Animals including humans We will learn about the different types of animal, their features and what animals eat.

## Computing

Computing systems and networks: We will be learning about technology around us and how to use a computer safely. We will develop our mouse and keyboard skills.  
Digital Safety: We will be understanding how to ask for help with pop ups, unreliable information and strangers online.

## PSHE

Kapow Families and relationships

We will learn about different types of families and how to build friendships and work through problems.

Health and wellbeing We will learn about healthy eating, sun safety, importance of sleep and personal hygiene.

## RE

In RE this half term we are learning about showing respect. We will learn about how Christians believe the world was created and the creation story. After half term we will be learning about the Christmas story in Christianity.

## History/Geography

History – Events within living memory: We will learn about how we have changed and how our local area has changed.

Geography – Continents, oceans, countries and capital cities: We will learn the names of continents, oceans, and the countries and seas of the UK.

## Music

In Music this term we will be studying Hey You! *by Joanna Mangona* which is an old-school hip hop tune. We will also listen to Rhythm In The Way We Walk (reggae style) and Banana Rap (hip hop style) by Joanna Mangona and Jane Sebba.

## Art /D&T

Art – Drawing and painting: We will be learning how to use different drawing techniques by exploring a range of different materials and tools.

D&T – Mechanisms and Structures: Building up the skills to create a pop-up/moving picture through design and problem solving.

## Home Learning

Home Learning is sent out weekly on a Friday and is due in on Wednesday. Home Learning will generally be set using Google Classroom.

Children should read every day and should be listened to doing so wherever possible. Please add your comments to the Reading Diaries.

The following books will be studied and enjoyed as a whole class:
