

Personal, Social and Emotional

Kapow – Building Relationships/ My family and friends – We will be focusing on talking about special people in our life and what makes a good friend

Kapow- My Wellbeing – We will be learning about ways to take care of ourselves and the importance of exercise

Physical Development

We will be focusing on our overall body strength, balance, co-ordination, and agility.

We will continue with daily busy fingers sessions to support the development of the children's fine motor skills.

Communication and Language

This term, our role-play area will be set up as a Green Grocers and an aeroplane.

We will be using talk to organise our play with our friends and engaging in extended conversations with our peers.

Phonics

We will continue to learn a new sound each week. The children will be clapping their hands to count out the syllables in words

We will also continue to note the sounds we hear in our environment.

Literacy

We will be exploring the following key texts: Summer 1 - Growing Olivers' Vegetables, Errol's garden, The Extraordinary Gardener, Do Baby Elephants Suck Their Trunks? and Splash.

This Half Term we will focus on being able to write the letters from our names.

Summer 2 – Moving On

The Suitcase, The Very Hungry Caterpillar, The Way Back Home, The Body Book, The Good Egg, The Queens Hat, I Am Nefertiti. This Half Term we will focus on being able to talk with confidence about our key texts.

Maths

Children will be starting to link numerals and amounts, solve real world mathematical problems up to 5 and compare quantities using language such as 'more than' and 'fewer than'.

Expressive Art and Design

The children will be developing their own stories, using the small world equipment to support them in their play. They will also be exploring different materials and considering how they can use them when creating.

PE

Summer 1 – Ball skills – This half term we will be learning how to roll and receive a ball. We will be throwing to a target, bouncing, catching, dribbling and kicking a ball.

Summer 2 – Games – This half term the children will learn how to play games, how to score and play by the rules. The children will learn how to work with a partner and understand what a team is.

Understanding the World

Children will continue to learn about the differences we have within our class and learn to celebrate those differences. Children will explore place knowledge and seasonal changes. They will also look at the life cycle of a plant.
