

English

We are starting the term with a narrative unit based on the book, The Lost Homework. We will then focus on non-fiction writing (instructions and recounts) before returning to a narrative unit and poetry. Spelling and handwriting will continue.

PE

This term we will be teaching the following units:

- Team Building
- Invasion
- Striking and Fielding
- Athletics

Maths

The main skills we will be covering this term include: finding fractions ($\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$) of amounts and shapes, properties of shapes, symmetry, and money.

We will continue to practice the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Science

Plants: We will look at how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants and find out what plants need to grow and stay healthy.

Revisit – Living things and their habitats & Animals, including humans.

Computing

Programming Quizzes: We will learn how to use and modify designs to create our own quiz questions using programming software.

Pictograms: We will learn how to collect and organise data using pictograms, and use the data to answer questions.

PSHE

Relationships: We will learn about why families are special, people we can trust and types of touch that we like/dislike.

Changes: We will focus on physical changes as we grow older and the differences between boys and girls.

RE

Community and Belonging Key Question: Does going to a Mosque give Muslims a sense of belonging?

Hajj Key Question: Does completing Hajj make a person a better Muslim?

History/Geography

History – we will complete our learning based on the history of Hatfield, and revisit The Great Fire of London.

Geography – We will be learning Fieldwork and Map skills around our local area and learning about the Yanomami People of the rainforest.
